Contribution to meeting UNSDGs

- There is a pressing need for new Grade A office floorspace in the city, much of the existing office stock has been lost to Permitted Developments (mainly student accommodation and hotels) and expanding businesses are leaving Bath. Economic forecasts indicate that, to deliver the required level of economic growth and in particular to facilitate the expansion of the key business sectors, up to 50,000 sq m of modern centrally located floorspace is required.
- Bath Quays is the most significant new office development in the World Heritage City of Bath for 25 years. It will become an inspiring and vibrant quarter for Bath's flourishing businesses and will be the hub of the Bath City Riverside Enterprise Zone.
